# JESUS IS THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD

We come to know the true God in the person of His Son the Lord Jesus. In John chapter twenty, our Lord Jesus Christ had gone to Calvary, bled and died for our sins. He had been buried in a borrowed tomb and had come forth from the grave alive forevermore. He had revealed Himself as the resurrected Saviour to His disciples.

Read the account in John 20:24-31. The Bible says in verse thirty-one, *“Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.”*

The question all of us must answer is found in Matthew 22:41, *“What think ye of Christ?”* The question of who Christ is remains the foundational issue of Christianity. This is why there is such an awful attack on His Person.

Peter said in Matthew 16:16, *“Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.”* Jesus Christ is who He says He is; He is God. You need to know Him as your Saviour.

## THE LORD ACCEPTED WHAT THE OLD TESTAMENT SAID ABOUT HIM

Luke 24:27 says, *“And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.”* Our Lord Jesus accepted what the Old Testament declared about Him, that He is God.

## Lesson 1

Isaiah 9:6 says that He is *“the mighty God”* and *“the everlasting Father.”* The Lord Jesus accepted these titles for Himself.

Jesus Christ is who He says He is, or He is a liar and an imposter. But He is not a liar; He is not an imposter. Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.

## JESUS CHRIST AFFIRMED THAT HE IS GOD IN THE NEW TESTAMENT



*Jesus Christ is not a liar; He is not an imposter. He is God.*

In John 5:17-23, those listening had no doubt about what Christ was affirming. He made Himself equal with God.

*Jesus Said He Is Equal with God in Works (v. 19)*

*Jesus Said He Is Equal with God in Knowledge (v. 20)*

*Jesus Said He Is Equal with God in Power (v. 21)*

*Jesus Said He Is Equal with God in Honor (v. 22-23)*

We also find many other examples of His claims. In John 8:58 He said, *“Before Abraham was, I am.”* This expression, *“I am,”* is the same name for God given in the Old Testament. He affirms Himself that He is God.

In John 10:30, the Lord Jesus said, *“I and my Father are one.”*

In John 19:7, the Jews were concluding their case for Christ to be put to death. They said, *“...by our law he ought to die, because he made himself the Son of God.”*



## Lesson 1

# JESUS CHRIST IS WHO HE SAYS HE IS, AND WE CAN KNOW GOD

If the Scriptures teach us that Christ accepted what the Bible says about Him in the Old Testament, if He affirmed in the Gospel records that He is God, where does this leave us? It leaves us with the wonderful truth that because Christ is who He says He is, we can know God.

Read John 14:5-9. In this passage, Christ declares to Philip that He indeed is God. There is nothing to be said that is true of God that is not true of Christ.

Dear ones, this is not just a good idea; it is absolutely the most important matter in life that Jesus is God and that we can know the Lord Jesus as our personal Saviour. Not only can we know Him, but we can also tell others how they can know Him as their personal Saviour.
